ON THE BALLOT

What is being proposed

- ◆ **Renewal** of an existing 5.0-mill property tax – **not a new tax.**
- ◆ **10-year term** running 2028 through 2037.
- ◆ Estimated **\$2 million in annual revenue** for the District.

WHAT IT FUNDS

Where the dollars go

- ◆ Levee construction and maintenance along 48 miles of levee protection.
- ◆ Drainage pumps and floodgate operations.
- ◆ Hurricane and storm-surge protection upgrades.

FUNDING REALITY

Why local dollars matter

- ◆ SLLD receives **no federal funding.**
- ◆ After Katrina, SLLD acted quickly to protect residents – building with local funds, to prevent area flooding.

PROVEN PROTECTION

Tested by Hurricane Ida

Over the past decade, SLLD increased the height of **48 miles of levees by an average of 2 feet.** That investment made a real difference during Ida:

- ◆ Helped prevent widespread flooding despite a **16-foot storm surge.**
- ◆ Without these improvements, the entire town of **Golden Meadow** – and most of **Galliano, Cut Off, and Larose** – would have flooded.

LOOKING AHEAD

What renewal makes possible

- ◆ Maintain and improve existing infrastructure.
- ◆ Continue raising the height of the levees.
- ◆ Prepare for future storms and rising water levels.
- ◆ Pursue federal authorization for higher levees and federal funding.
